

WHAT IS THE PARENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE?

(Also known as PAC)

We are the parents of the children enrolled at TLC: The Learning Center. The PAC is made up of volunteers consisting of parents/guardians, staff and is monitored by the Director.

We believe in the mission statement and the goals set forth by the Board of Directors as stated in the Parent Handbook. We will help, to the best of our abilities, to carry out these ideals.

PAC meets once a month, the day and time will be posted. We meet in the conference room at TLC. This is a time to meet and talk to other parents, the Director and the Financial Manager about ideas benefiting children and parents. *This is YOUR chance to have input on activities and policies affecting TLC!*

Free childcare and a meal are provided for the children and for the parents that attend the meeting.

During the meetings, it is understood that policies and procedures are to be discussed...not events that point to one particular staff member. Should there be a concern about staff, it is advised to speak privately to the lead person of the classroom involved.

We are the voice of the parents to the staff.

With the approval from the Board of Directors, the PAC may raise money to benefit the center. One of our fund raising activities is selling beverages at the Party in the park during the summer months. Parents volunteer to set up, sell beverages and tear down the stand.
